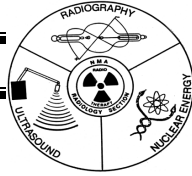

2024 HIGHLIGHTS NMA MEETING-NEW YORK



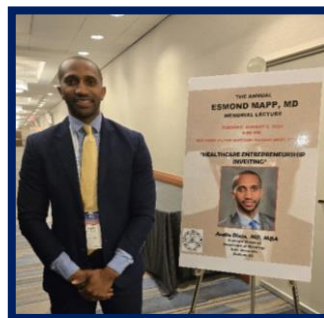

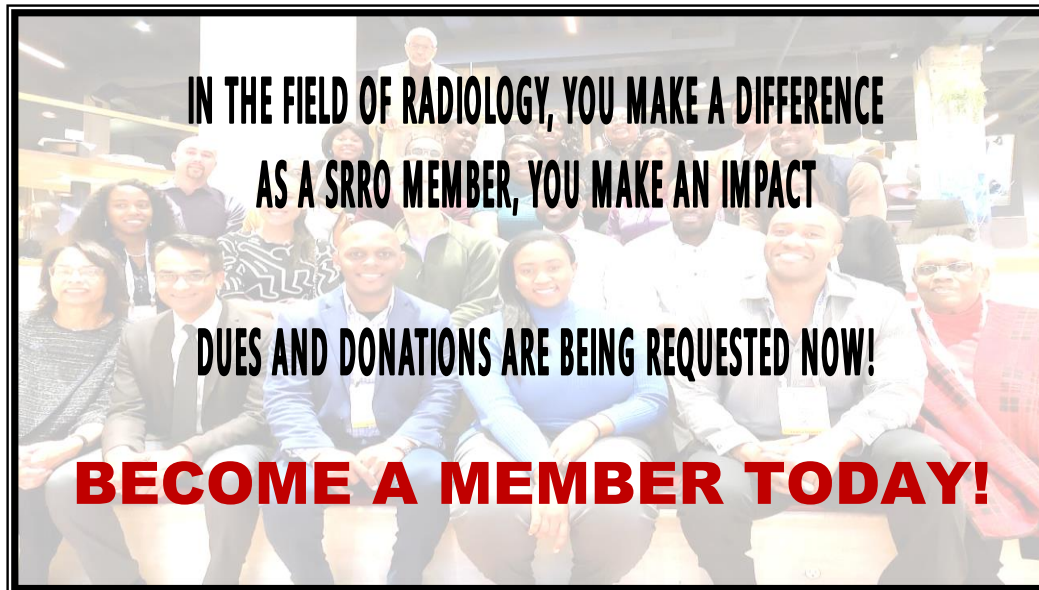

This honor is awarded by the ACR Board of Chancellors to individuals who demonstrate extraordinary service to the discipline of radiology. We congratulate you and are excited to celebrate this milestone at the 2025 ACR conference in Washington, DC.



Dr. Beverly Coleman to be recognized during ACR 2025 Annual Meeting

The American College of Radiology® (ACR®) Board of Chancellors named three Gold Medalists and three Honorary Fellows in recognition of their extraordinary contributions to the field of radiology and outstanding service to the ACR. Honorees will be recognized during the ACR 2025 Annual Meeting in Washington, DC, May 3–7.

Beverly G. Coleman, MD, FACR, is the first African American to be elected president of the College and continues as a member of the Judiciary Committee. She is the first director of fetal imaging at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia Center for Fetal Diagnosis and Treatment and the inaugural holder of the Beverly Gilbert Coleman Endowed Chair in Fetal Imaging.

Jacqueline A. Bello, MD, FACR, is the recipient of the 2024 Gold Medal Award from the American Society of Neuroradiology (ASNR). She is a professor of neuroradiology at Montefiore and the Albert Einstein College of Medicine. Her research and contributions focus on areas such as:

- Adult and pediatric neuroradiology
- Medical education
- Quality and safety
- Healthcare policy
- Febrile status epilepticus
- Temporal lobe epilepsy

Dr. Bello has also received other awards, including:

- The Columbia University President's Gold Medal
- The Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons Alumni Medal - Meritorious Service

Dr. Bello was also the chair of the ACR Board of Chancellors from 2022–2024. She chaired the ACR Commission on Quality and Safety, Commission on Government Relations, and Commission on International Relations.

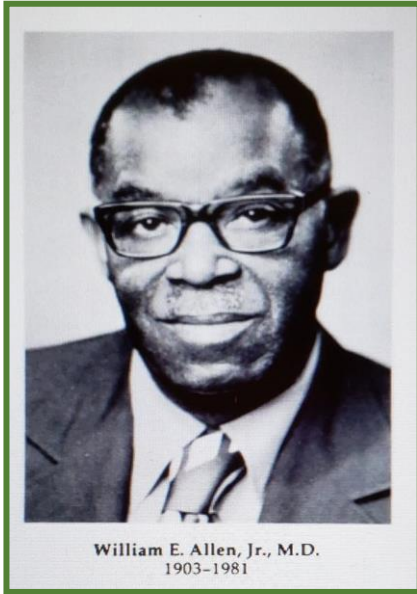

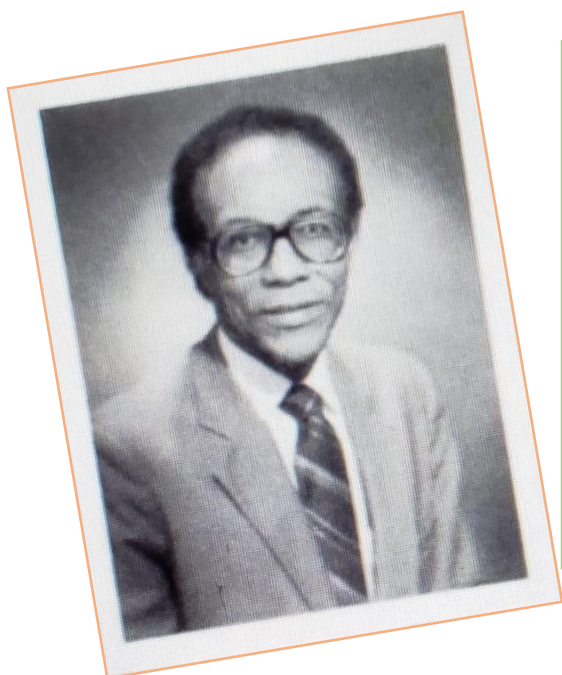

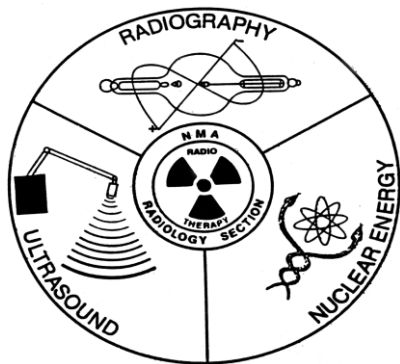
